



## Ingram Micro Raises Record Amount at Its 17<sup>th</sup> Annual West Coast Charity Golf Tournament

"We started our popular charity golf tournament in 1993 as a way to raise money and continue Ingram Micro's tradition of giving back to our local community," said Keith Bradley, president, Ingram Micro North America. "Since then, we have raised nearly \$1 million, which has been given to 50 local non-profit organizations."

Held at the Tustin Ranch Golf Course in Tustin, Calif., the tournament drew 152 players, including Ingram Micro executives, associates and family members, customers and vendors. Following the early morning tournament, participants attended an awards banquet and presentation of the proceeds to the benefiting organizations. The tournament was made possible with support from 51 sponsors.
