



## **LOCAL COMPANIES PARTICIPATED IN NATIONAL FAMILY VOLUNTEER DAY AT THE ORANGE COUNTY FOOD BANK**

Garden Grove, Calif., On Saturday, November 19, over 1,100 volunteers representing ten of Orange County's largest companies broke the Orange County Food Bank's record for the largest number of food boxes assembled in one day. Volunteers participating in the Food Bank's holiday-time National Family Volunteer Day event packaged 26,306 food boxes for vulnerable seniors.

"Orange County's most successful corporations harnessed their competitive spirit during this huge volunteer event," said Food Bank Director, Mark Lowry. "The result is that thousands of seniors living on fixed incomes will receive the food that they need this holiday season," added Lowry.

The family member of employees from the Disneyland Resort, Wells Fargo, Ingram Micro, First American, KPMG, KPMG-LLP, Experian, Edison International, Broadcom, and Pacific Life worked side-by-side to package 421 tons of food.

The volunteers on Saturday surpassed the Food Bank's former record for the largest number of food boxes by more than 2,700 food boxes; a record established in 2009. This year, volunteers also surpassed the milestone of having assembled in excess of 100,000 food boxes during the five year history of the National Family Volunteer Day event at the Orange County Food Bank. This has grown to become one of the largest National Family Volunteer Day events in the country.
